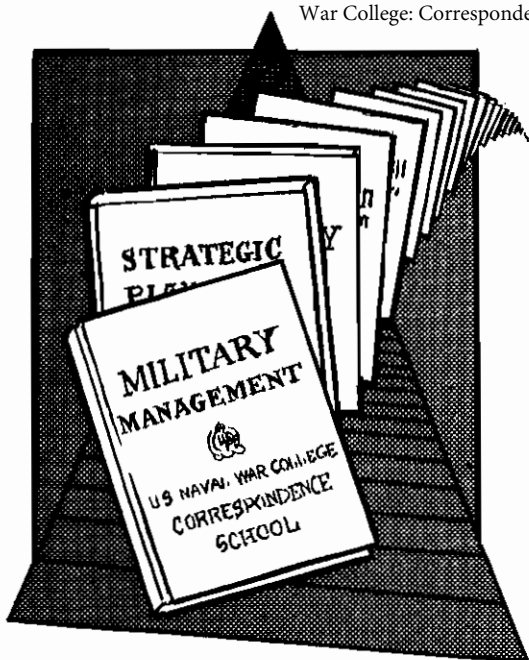

Correspondence Courses in Perspective

MILITARY MANAGEMENT

A new correspondence course, *Military Management*, is now available at the Naval War College. This course will provide the student an opportunity to further his appreciation for the principles, processes, concepts, applications and techniques inherent in sound military management. It is structured to highlight the following areas of interest: the functions of management; the history and background of managerial thought; interdisciplinary foundations for management; defense as an economic problem; scientific aids

to decision making; the role of computers; Navy planning, programming, and budgeting; the management of resources; and future trends in military management.

The course is administered in three installments whose broad titles are: Foundations of Management, Explorations in Military Management, and Application of Military Management. Each installment is weighted at 13 retirement points for reserve officers for a total of 39 retirement points upon completion of the course.
